- Entries must be in the form of Painting and Drawing, Photography or Graphic Design
- Entries must be A3 size only.
- Entries can be from any young person (12 to 25 years) living in the City of Greater Dandenong, City of Casey or Cardinia Shire

Age groups:

- There will be two age categories:
 - 12-16 years
 - 17-25 years

How to submit your entry (accompanied with an entry form):

- Your original artwork must be dropped off at the Southern Migrant and Refugee Centre – 39 Clow St Dandenong (next to Dandenong Market) along with an entry form which can be downloaded from the SMRC website www.smrc.org.au
